- 4. Does she mean this literally? "Did you think I'd lay down and die"? If not, what does it symbolize?
- 5. What do you think is the main issue of the song what has happened prior to the song?
- 6. What could be the message to the ones who listen to the song, apart from the one she sings to?
- 7. Can you find any metaphors or symbolism for other issues or topics?
- 8. The common interpretation of the song is that it is about a woman overcoming a heartbreak, but can this song be interpreted in other ways?
